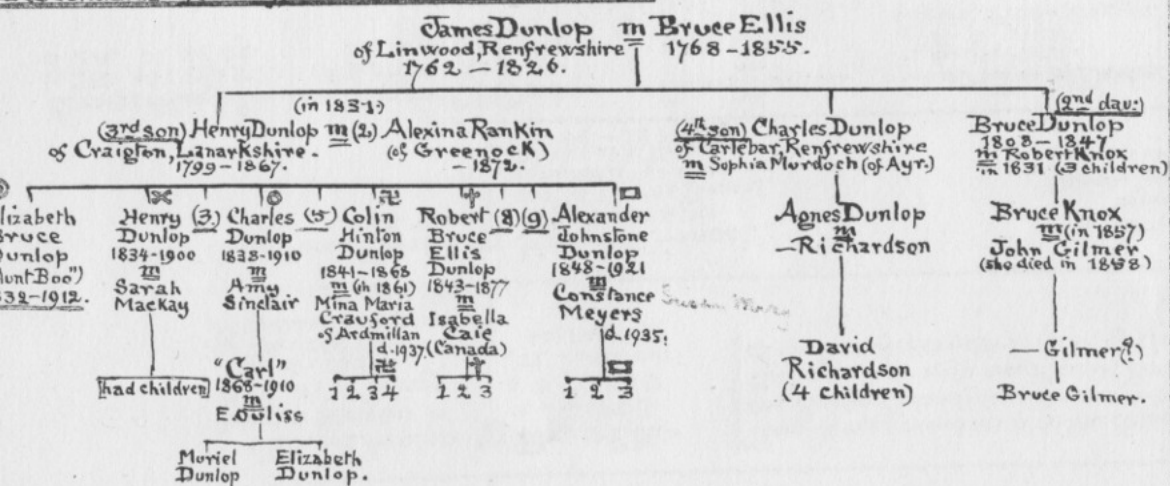
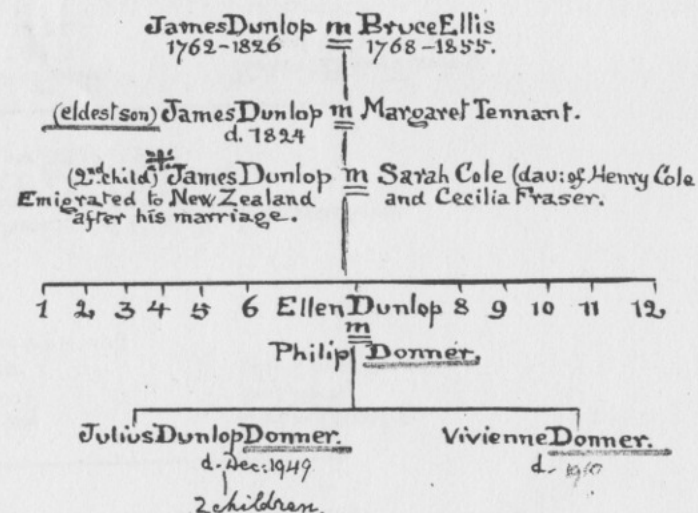


Descendants of Henry, Charles and Bruce Dunlop.

COPIES OF PARTS OF LETTERS FROM WILLIAM AND HENRY DUNLOP

SENT WITH PORTRAIT TO CHARLES TENNANT DUNLOP

"Glasgow, 26th Oct. 1855

Dear Charles,

We are disposing of the portraits in the house at Wemyss Place, Edinr, and propose to send you my Father's portrait if you would like to receive it. It was a present from Mr Dunn, in return for the plan of a Water Wheel which he values highly. I daresay you will remember the picture. It is half length and was considered a good likeness.....

I remain yours affectionately,
Henry Dunlop".

(Note: This was Henry Dunlop of Craigton, ²Father of "Aunt Boo" (Elizabeth Bruce Dunlop 1832-1912) The picture is of James Dunlop of Doucat Hall, 1762-1826. [Page 82.] J.M.F.T.née R.)

"Redheughs Farm, 2nd Novr, 1855.

Dear Charles,

My brother Henry informs me that you have accepted the portrait of our Father (your Grandfather) to be preserved in your family.....We have sent the portrait of our Mother to Dr & Mrs Lang, to remain with them during their lives and then to go to your - (sic!).....pleased to think the paintings will be placed in the hands of one worthy to receive them.....

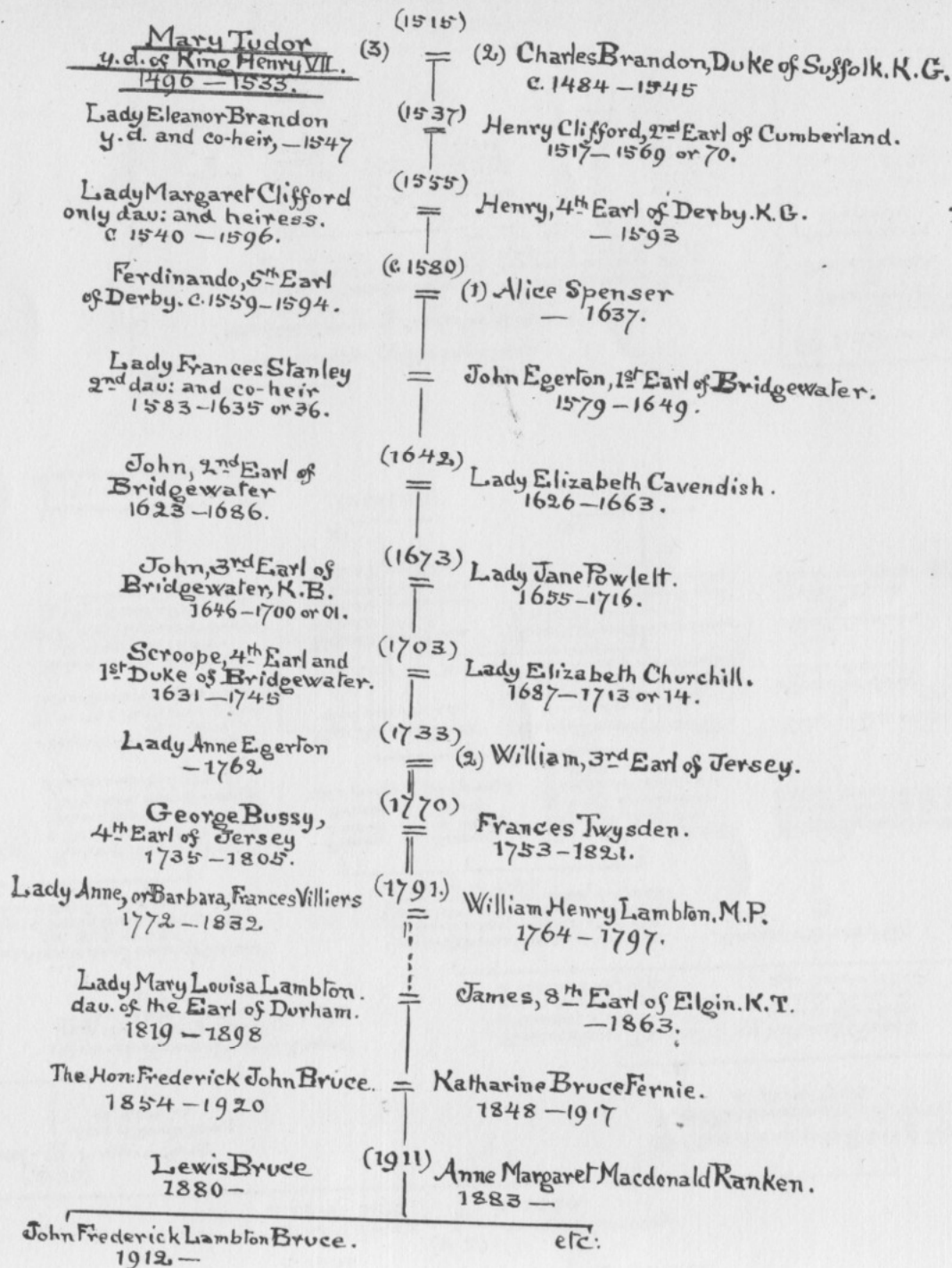
